### General notes

March 12th 2024.

- 1) Introduction part (12:00-12:50h): Stevan Savic opened the WG1/WG2 meeting and made introduction of two-days agenda.
- 2) Fair Micomet Portal topic (12:15-14:00h): Mark Roantree lead and presented the concept of the FMP and discuss more about steps and issues of accessing to FMP platform, then some possible issues in connection of FMP and Zenodo platforms. For further users and all technical issues in the forthcoming period Damhan Richardson will be responsible. The general conclusion is that the FMP should be included in the further project proposals.
- 3) FAIR principles (15:00-16:30h): Branislava Lalic presented problems with mainstreaming the concept of FAIR principles. We discussed how to stimulate the community to share the data or at least metadata of meteorological networks or stations. Also, some possibilities to connect with some international organizations (such as UMETNET) in order to enlarge accessibility to datasets. Furthermore, we discussed to propose and encourage some of climatology journals to demand raw datasets as one of criteria in the 'Instruction for authors'. One of the solution that this initiative will be acceptable for editors is to create the online tool to analyze the gaps in the data (to make the gap profile of the data).
- 4) FAIRNESS project (17:00-18:00h): Pavol Nejedlik presented the project budget situation and new more strict rules for reimbursement justifications. Also, we discussed about STSM current situation and accepted a new initiative that prepare a new scientific paper of our project and submit in a new journal 'Journal of European meteorological society'.

March 13th 2024

- 1) UMN paper (10:00-11.30h) Jelena Dunjic presented the search methodology and current progress in work. Also, it was define the contributors per each task in the search action and defined general timeline when we can expect final list of papers and urban networks.
