The COST Action CA20108 – FAIR Network of micrometeorological measurements (FAIRNESS) – is pleased to announce its **2nd FAIRNESS Conference**, scheduled for the 8th and 9th of April 2025 in Sarajevo, Bosnia and Herzegovina. We invite researchers, practitioners, policymakers, and stakeholders from various disciplines to submit abstracts for oral and poster presentations.

The conference will focus on enhancing standardization and integration of micrometeorological measurements, promoting FAIR (Findable, Accessible, Interoperable, Reusable) data principles, and exploring their applications in environmental and social sustainability. We welcome contributions related, but not limited, to the following themes:

Conference Themes

1. Networking and Communication

- a. Building Collaborative Networks for FAIR Micrometeorological Data (*e.g., fostering multidisciplinary partnerships*).
- b. Addressing Gaps in Data Sharing and Interoperability (*e.g., enhancing compatibility across observational networks*).

2. Development and Implementation

- a. Innovations in Measurement Techniques for Micrometeorological Research (*e.g., new tools for small-scale monitoring*).
- b. Standardization of Observational Data Across Diverse Environments (*e.g., harmonizing protocols for rural and urban settings*).

3. Dissemination and Application



- a. Demonstrating Socio-Economic Benefits of Micrometeorological Data (*e.g., applications in agriculture, urban planning, and forestry*).
- b. Tools and Platforms for Enhancing FAIR Data Accessibility (*e.g., Micromet_KSP and other knowledge-sharing frameworks*).

4. Beyond FAIRNESS Strategies

- a. Expanding FAIRNESS Principles to Address Global Challenges (*e.g., climate change adaptation and mitigation*).
- b. Designing Sustainable Roadmaps for Future Data Networks (*e.g., long-term strategies for FAIR data integration*).

Submission Guidelines

Abstracts must be submitted in English and should not exceed 300 words. Submissions should include:

- Title of the presentation.
- Author(s) name(s), affiliation(s), and contact information.
- A clear indicator of COST FAIRNESS membership per author.
- A requirement for reimbursement (YES or NO answer).
- A clear indication of the preferred presentation format (in person or online).
- The relevant conference theme.
